



Arman Shaikenov is one of post-Soviet's foremost legal scholars and practitioners, with more than two decades of experience in civil law, constitutional law, and jurisprudence. As counsel and partner in leading Kazakh law firms and during his tenure at McGuireWoods, an international law firm renowned for cross-border work, he represented the Republic of Kazakhstan in major international arbitrations under the LCIA, AAA, and SCC Rules.
