



Dr Mathias Wittinghofer, born in 1974, studied law and obtained his doctorate in Münster, Westphalia, and passed his second state examination at the Higher Regional Court in Frankfurt am Main. He is doubly qualified as a lawyer in Germany and as a solicitor in England and Wales. He is a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (FCIArb) and was a member of the European Branch Committee. He is also a member of several arbitration institutions. He has gained experience in all types of commercial litigation and national and international arbitration proceedings, with a particular focus on capital market and post-M&A disputes, both as a party representative and as an arbitrator, in over 20 years as a partner in international commercial law firms. In addition, Mathias Wittinghofer has acted as both litigation counsel and arbitrator in joint venture disputes, corporate D&O liability matters and intellectual property cases, including patents, utility models and designs. Mathias Wittinghofer also represents and advises parties in follow-on antitrust damages actions. Mathias Wittinghofer has completed specialist training as a specialist lawyer for banking and capital market law, published several articles on banking and finance law and international arbitration, and given numerous lectures on both topics.
