



Professor Stavros Brekoulakis is the Michael and Laura Hwang Professor of International Arbitration at the National University of Singapore and practises as an arbitrator at 3 Verulam Buildings (Gray's Inn), London.

He is widely regarded as a leading authority in the field of international arbitration and has been recognised as a Who's Who Legal: Global Elite Thought Leader in Arbitration. He has led major research initiatives and has advised governments, intergovernmental organisations, and NGOs on complex policy and legislative matters. His scholarship includes several monographs, edited volumes, and numerous articles published in leading international law journals.

In recognition of his academic contributions, he has been invited to deliver the prestigious Summer Course on Private International Law at the Hague Academy of International Law in 2026.

Professor Brekoulakis holds senior editorial roles in several prominent international law journals. He currently serves as Vice President of the International Court of Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) and is a member of the Governing Board of the International Council for Commercial Arbitration (ICCA).
